

## Year 11 PSHE Day – Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2020

Dear Year 11 Parents / Carers,

Year 11 students would normally all attend a full taster day at Henley College in mid-November during the second PSHE Day of the year. This event is to provide them with information about the range of post-16 courses available at the College and to focus their minds on post-16 applications.

We have just received details of what Henley College will be offering this year which is in the form of a single one hour online session in the middle of the day. This does not fit well with the current structure of our school day and has also provided us with only very limited time to make other arrangements for the day. As the rest of the school will be involved in a PSHE Day with staffing groups already allocated, we do not have much flexibility to move things round.


