Oxfordshire County Council may provide free transport (or meet the cost of travel) for your child if he or she meets the criteria described in the Council's Home to School Transport Policy. This is typically where a child attends their nearest school and lives over the statutory walking distance (which for secondary aged students is 3 miles).

To find out if your child is eligible and what support is available if they are not, click [Free and paid travel to school | Oxfordshire County Council](#) or visit <https://www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/residents/schools/travelling-school/free-and-paid-travel-school>.

You will have been informed by the Council's Schools Admissions Team if your child qualifies for free home to school travel. If you think your child may be eligible for this support, please contact Oxfordshire County Council, School Transport Eligibility Team by email: [schooltransporteligibility@oxfordshire.gov.uk](mailto:schooltransporteligibility@oxfordshire.gov.uk).

Alternatively, parents may be able to pay for spare seats if they are available on school buses operating for students who qualify for statutory transport. More information and online application can be found on the Oxfordshire County Council website. Please note that the deadline for applications for September 2023 is 30 June 2023. There is also no guarantee that a seat will be able to be offered for sale for September, so you should also plan in case your application is unsuccessful. There are also local public buses that serve Gillotts School. Parents of students who live closer to another available school but choose to come to Gillotts should contact the bus company operating the route nearest to their home to make their own arrangements. Transport costs for pupils in these circumstances are the responsibility of parents.

The current bus routes are listed below but stops and times do vary slightly from year to year depending on demand, so it is best to check with the relevant bus companies directly and not rely solely on this information.
